# Story

*New Orleans, June 25, 1895*

*My dear Edmond,*

*I found upon my return home to dinner yesterday, your letter informing me of your affection for Annie and asking that we confide her future happiness to your keeping...*

This excerpt is from a letter written by Kathryn Podorsky's great-great-grandfather, Lucien Doize, responding to a request by Edmond to marry his daughter, Annie. The letter was not only beautiful contextually, but exquisitely penned and epitomized the delightful period charm of the New Orleans people.

Vena Amoris, or "Vein of Love" refers to a phrase coined by Henry Swinburne in his *A Treatise of Espousal* published in 1686. Vena Amoris also refers to the fourth finger on the left hand which was traditionally believed to contain a vein running directly to the heart, hence "the ring finger."

As a digital font, Vena Amoris boasts an extensive Latin-based glyph repertoire that supports 310 languages. Also included are stylistic and contextual alternates, ligatures, swash variants, oldstyle figures, automatic roman numerals, and embellished

words, imbuing a vivacious quality and grace to any setting. All of those extra goodies are driven by cleverly engineered OpenType features allowing you to easily bring harmony and beauty into your layouts.
